It's 1938 and Elise is a 19-year-old Jewish girl who flees Vienna and arrives at the estate of an aristocratic family in England to join their household as a servant.



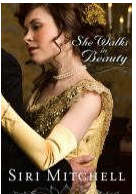
The House of Mirth

For a young society woman in the late 1890s, the future of her family depends on how she plays the game.



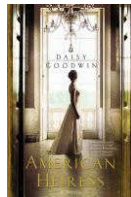
