Please check back regularly to watch our chain grow and read what others are saying about Bullitt County Public Library.



Tips from the Circulation Department




Hello, I'm Cindy, the Branch Manager at Ridgway Memorial Library and Supervisor of the Circulation Department.

Did you know? BCPL card holders may borrow books and other items from lending libraries nationwide through our Interlibrary Loan service. Ask a library staff member for details or call us!




Hello, I'm Mona, the Branch Manager at Hillview Library.
