• How will the Stottman Annex support the revitalized branch (public services, special event space, staff only, unknown)? Would you consider potentially using the facility for library functions if it's advantageous for BCPL functionally or financially?

The Dorothea Stottman Annex is used in several different ways currently and will continue to function this way in the future. It is used for the storage of large items (i.e. programming, furniture, and facilities). It also is used as a "home" for our Friends of the Library. Currently discarded books for the Booksale are stored here. The Booksales will be held at this location, with half of the Annex becoming a Friends of the Library bookstore in the future. Lastly, our Technology Department has some of our electronic resources housed at the Annex. Beyond joining the parking lots to allow for parking and easier travel from Terry Blvd. and Hillview Blvd. to the renovated, expanded Hillview Branch, there are no thoughts beyond Booksales and Friends of the Library activities, to use it for BCPL functions.
